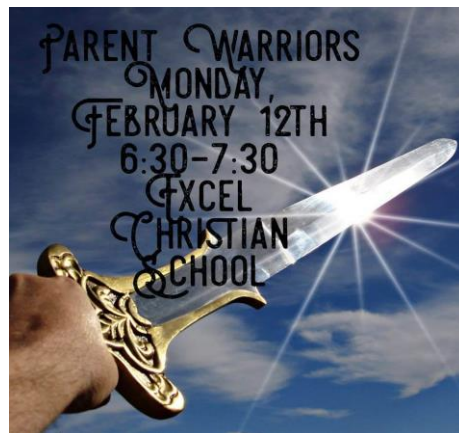

COLD & FLU SEASON

As you are aware, flu season is upon us. Washoe County is reporting higher-than-usual rates, including several flu-related deaths. One of the keys to preventing the spread of this illness is for infected people to remain home.

Please follow these firm guidelines in deciding if your child is too ill to attend school:

1. Is he/she learning ready? That is: able to participate in classroom lessons, recess and PE.
2. Are they fever free? Children should be fever free and WITHOUT MEDICATION for 24 hours. Also, children with a nagging cough can be a distraction in the classroom.

Please remember that children should not be sent to school with medication to give themselves. All medications should be kept in the nurse's office. The nurse will need a signed medicine administration form on hand to administer meds.

Any child who has flu-like symptoms will be required to wear a mask while waiting for a parent to pick them up. This will prevent the spread of infection to others.

We appreciate your support and cooperation.



We are excited to announce Excel will have its first swim team this spring. This will be a varsity sport open to grades 9-12. To join you must be very comfortable in the water and able to swim across the pool easily. Transportation to Alf Sorenson will need to be arranged for practice.

Swimming's first official day of practice will be Monday, February 26. Practice will be from 3-4pm Monday-Thursday through the season at Alf Sorenson. The season will last through mid-May. Before the season starts in February we will have some open swim time available to get skills down before the season begins. If you have not been on a swim team before, this would be highly encouraged. If you already belong to one of the local club teams (Piranhas, Reno Aquatic, Northern Nevada or Lakeridge) you would be encouraged to come and workout with them.

For practice you will need a one-piece swimsuit, goggles and a towel.

Starting the second week of March we will have a swim meet on Friday or Saturday each week. Everyone will be expected to participate in each meet.

The cost for this sport will be \$200.00.
