The quiet and calm on our campus was noticeable. Not a person was to be seen (other than our security personnel) and not a voice could be heard. It was eerie - if I didn't know better, I would have sworn that no one was present. The lock-down was changed to yellow, and shortly afterwards it was lifted altogether, and our campus sprang back to life. I was proud of our students and our staff - everyone did what we expected them to do; children were safe and our campus was locked down tightly. Kudos to everyone, and thank you Jesus, for protecting Excel. His presence is always our first line of defense.
