TIPS FOR SCHOOLS: WHAT'S NEXT FOR 529 SAVINGS PLANS? Article by: P. George Tryfiates, ACSI Director for Government Affairs

Thanks to the new tax reform law, parents have a new vehicle to help them afford Christian school education. One provision which ACSI (Association of Christian Schools International) strongly supported in the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act expanded qualified expenses from 529 savings plans to include K-12 tuition. A parent may now use earnings from his or her 529 savings plan to help cover tuition expenses at their Christian school. Federal law will not tax the earnings, as it does in a regular savings account or investment. Many states match that feature of federal law and offer additional tax breaks. As of 2018, parents may use up to \$10,000 from their 529 savings account to help pay for their Christian school tuition.
