IMPORTANT INFORMATION YOU NEED TO KNOW

If your child needs any medication during the school day, school policy is that the medication will be kept in the nurses' office. In addition, a consent form, which requires signature by both the healthcare provider and the parent, is required for our nurse to administer or oversee your child receiving the medication.
